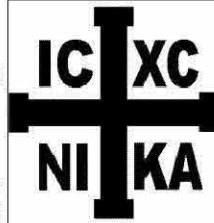

Patriarch John visits Britain & Ireland to enthrone its first Antiochian Metropolitan

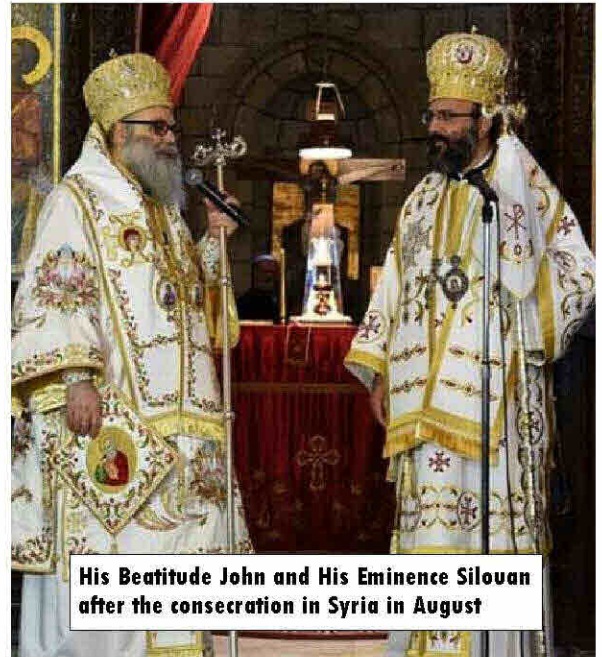
The moment, the *kairon*, has come. At the end of this month of November we shall have our Bishop installed, if not actually living here until the New Year.

We have been praying for a Bishop to care for us ever since the last, Archbishop JOHN, was elected Patriarch of Antioch and All the East three years ago. Now we have one.

In his addresses to date the new Bishop has displayed a strong love for us already. In his latest, address he speaks to the Clergy of the British Isles but it has been read also to the laity in church. He shows his attachment to us even before he has met us. He is a young man of intelligence and ability and of devotion to the ways of Christ.

St Helen's is 200m down behind the George Hotel in the High Street, but accessible from there only on foot. By car: leave Middleborough Roundabout (between dual carriageways Westway and Balkerne Hill), to Northgate; go straight along St Peter's Street to Castle Park; continue round the bend, up into Maidenburgh Street. The nearest car park is Nunns Road NCP, off St Peter's Street.
